Like C. S. Lewis, Billie shares with us the proper way to be fully human. Billie's style is straight forward and strong as in "Plug holes, build bridges, intercept criminals, connect families, remove danger, bring healing, bless friends, and strengthen your nation in prayer." This "no nonsense" writer stays true to the course, yet softens the message just when we need it by including a discussion on beauty, and " God Bless her forever" reveals God's deliverance in a quote regarding chemotherapy and the blood of the lamb.
